We address access issues with landowners; cut and clear trails; design, construct and maintain bridges; and groom the trails for the use of snowmobilers and others.

The KTS trail system is clearly marked and carefully maintained for the safety and enjoyment of responsible winter sports enthusiasts. While you are enjoying the trails, we ask that you respect the rights of landowners, obey all signs, respect wildlife and other trail users.

The dues you pay bring many benefits, not the least of which is the use of a premium trail system. We receive assistance from the State of New Hampshire Bureau of Trails through it's grant-in-aid program (funded by your registration fees) but we could not survive to provide quality grooming without the active participation of our members.
